Purpose

OCP International Partnership Association, Inc. (OCP-IP) is an independent, non-profit semiconductor industry consortium formed to administer the support, promotion and enhancement of the Open Core Protocol (OCP) and the specification for use of the OCP (Specification). OCP is the first fully supported, openly licensed, comprehensive, interface socket for semiconductor intellectual property cores. The mission of OCP-IP is to address problems relating to design, verification and testing which are common to intellectual property core reuse in "plug and play" system-on-chip (SOC) products.

Benefits and Obligations of Membership

Membership in OCP-IP is open to intellectual property companies, integrated device manufacturers, system companies or design houses, among others, interested in the semiconductor industry and SOC products.

Membership benefits include the following:

- Access to industrial grade tools that support OCP.
- Free access to all membership products, tools and services.
- Hot-line support, on-line documentation and training materials.
- Participation in OCP-IP events, working committees and member meetings.
- Access to the Members-only Website.
- The ability to contribute to OCP enhancements and access specifications in both draft and adopted form.

Members also have the following obligations:

- All members agree to pay applicable dues as set forth in the Membership Agreement and as determined by the Governing Steering Committee.
- Members agree to abide by OCP-IP policies and rules, including all provisions set forth in the Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws, Membership Agreement and the Antitrust Guidelines.

- Members agree that upon pre-approval by the member concerned, OCP-IP may utilize member's company name/logo in public statements describing OCP-IP membership.
- Members agree that their names may be filed with the Antitrust Division of the U.S. Department of Justice and the Federal Trade Commission in order for OCP-IP and its members to receive the protections from antitrust liability under the National Cooperative Research and Production Act of 1993, 15 U.S.C. §4301.
- Members agree to keep confidential the passwords to OCP-IP Websites among their own employees who have a need to use the OCP-IP Websites and to not provide copies of the Specification or any OCP related documentation to non-authorized persons.

Membership Classes

OCP-IP has three classes of membership - Governing Steering Committee (GSC) Members, Sponsor Members and Community Members. The classes of membership are described more fully in the Membership Information section of the OCP-IP website. GSC Members function as the Board of Directors of OCP-IP.

Dues

Current annual dues for Community Members are \$10,000. Current annual dues for Sponsor Members are \$25,000. Annual dues for GSC Members are determined by the GSC.

Term

The term of membership shall be on a year-to-year basis, expiring on the 365th day after the later of receipt by OCP-IP of applicable dues and a completed Membership Application. OCP-IP will invoice members ninety (90) days prior to the expiration of the pending term and a member's payment thereof shall constitute a renewal of membership.

Termination

Any member may withdraw from membership by giving written notice of termination to the GSC. Members will be obligated to pay all dues, assessments and fees that have accrued prior to the effective date of termination. No dues, assessments or fees collected prior to termination will be refunded.

Simply by signing and faxing a completed copy of this Membership Application to the fax number below, Applicant can agree to abide by the policies and rules of the Association, as set forth in OCP-IP's Membership Documents (copies available upon request) and formally apply for Membership. No membership shall be binding on OCP-IP until the annual membership fee (**) designated for the particular class of membership selected above is received and accepted by OCP-IP. OCP-IP reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to accept or reject any application based upon the membership requirements and restrictions stated in OCP-IP's then current Bylaws.
